



International Student Letter from Bank or Financial Institution 2025-26

In order to be admitted to Mount Mary University and issued an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility Form, International students must submit the International Student Support Form and an official bank statement (on bank paper, no online banking documents without bank letterhead accepted) or a letter directly from the bank. Letters from the bank should contain the following information:

- Name of account holder
- Date of account balance
- Current account balance or specific acknowledgement that account has a minimum balance to cover student's estimated expenses (see International Student Support Form) for a minimum of one year
- Monetary values need to be converted to U.S. dollars
- The following statement should be included:

This is to certify that in our opinion, (Guarantor's Name), the guarantor whose signature appears on the International Student Support Form, has adequate funds to meet the estimated expenses as listed for the applicant and any dependents listed for each year the applicant is enrolled at Mount Mary University. This certificate does not constitute a statement of liability on any part or on behalf of the bank incurred by the applicant.
