

9 things to know about Title IX

- 1 Title IX prohibits discrimination in education programs that receive federal funding.
- 2 Sexual harassment and assault are types of discrimination Title IX bans.
- 3 Title IX applies to all genders, students, faculty, and staff.
- 4 Mount Mary has established procedures for handling complaints of gender discrimination & sexual assault.
- 5 MMU must take immediate action to ensure complainants continue their education free of ongoing harassment.
- 6 Mount Mary may not retaliate against someone filing a complaint & must keep complainants safe from retaliation.
- 7 MMU can issue "no contact" directives to prevent accused abusers from interacting with victims.
- 8 Sexual harassment and assault create a hostile environment that interferes with students' abilities to benefit from educational programs.

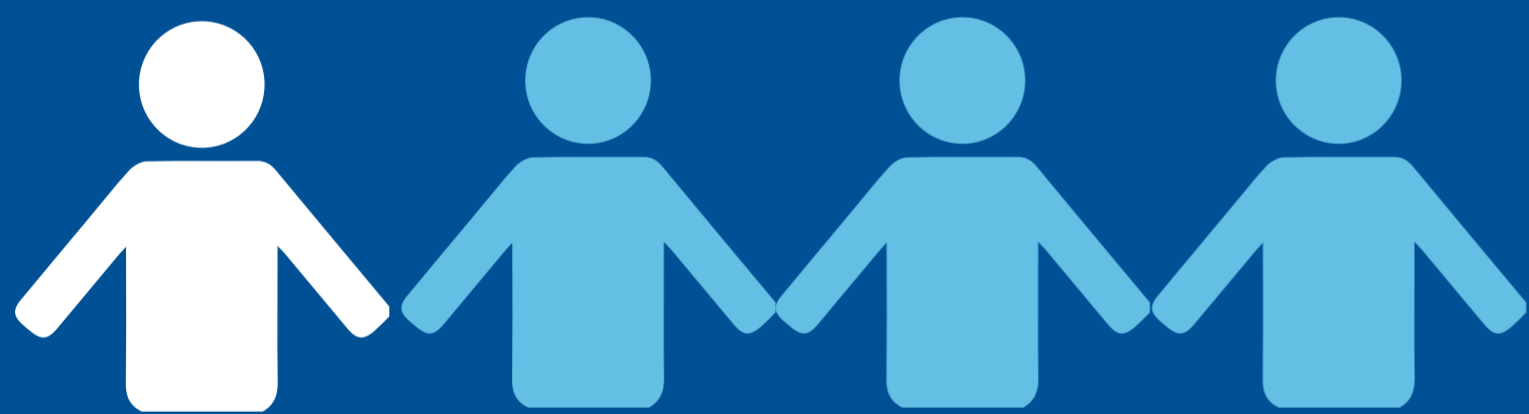
