Early Admission Program Progression Standards

Students entering Mount Mary University need to successfully meet the following progression standards to be eligible for the early admission decision process.

Any undergraduate student who enrolls at Mount Mary with less than 61 earned credits and meets all of the conditions below will have a spot in Mount Mary's professional entry graduate occupational therapy program.

- Cumulative GPA of 3.50 or higher**, which must be maintained throughout the completion of the student's undergraduate degree.
- Satisfactory earned grades on all identified occupational therapy prerequisite coursework** (listed below). Students must earn these grades on their first attempt and cannot retake these courses to meet this requirement.

Developmental Psychology	B or higher
Psychopathology or Abnormal Psychology	B or higher
Cultural Anthropology or Introductory to Sociology	B or higher
Human Anatomy	BC or higher
Human Physiology	BC or higher
Medical Terminology	B or higher
College Composition	B or higher
Statistics	B or higher
Oral Communication or Public Speaking	B or higher
Physics	BC or higher
Orientation to Occupational Therapy	B or higher

Note: Any student who does not meet the criteria for early admission, but does meet the overall criteria for application can follow the standard application and admission process to Mount Mary's graduate occupational therapy programs.
